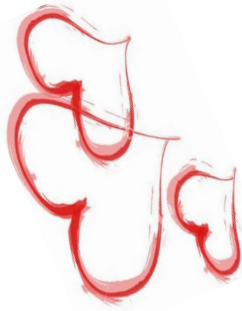

THE PASTOR'S PEN

Most of us when we turn to the month of February on our calendars will immediately try to identify the date February 14. Of course that is Valentine's Day and we certainly do not want to overlook that special day. To do so would likely land us on someone's "How dare you forget!" list. If you have identified the date you probably made the connection that Valentine's falls on a Wednesday but not any Wednesday. It is also Ash Wednesday which signals the beginning of the church season of Lent. Although having the two events occur on the same day may interfere with plans for a romantic dinner with a loved one, I have always felt when this did occur it was somehow appropriate. Lent reminds us of ashes, nails, sin, repentance, crosses and other "heavy" topics but when it commences on Valentine's Day it drives home the fact that "the heavy stuff" occurred because God chose to romance us into a loving relationship. Lent and Love are both four letter words straight from the heart of God. I also find it equally ironic that the season of Lent concludes on Easter Sunday which this year falls on April 1, commonly referred to as April Fool's Day (All Fool's Day. It seems appropriate because Easter is God's ultimate trick played on death and sin. Perhaps this is the reason I have always enjoyed singing the song "Lord of the Dance" because it seems as if Jesus recognizes that he has tricked death and dances as he sings:

They cut me down
And I leapt up high;
I am the life
That'll never, never die;
I'll live in you
If you'll live in me -
I am the Lord
Of the Dance, said he.

What is a Confirmation Class?

A "Confirmation Class" is a group of individuals who come together typically with their pastor for a time of study, prayer and reflection to learn some of the basic beliefs of a United Methodist Christian. One does not have to have been previously baptized as an infant to be a part of a class. The purpose of the class is to help someone understand what it means to be a Christian and how they can express this in their life. It is a time for them to consider becoming a Christian and a member of the church.

Attending a **Confirmation Class does not make a person a Christian.** Nor is it necessary for someone to attend such a class to become a Christian or become a full member of the Church. One can do this at any time and at any age. However such a class can help us recognize how God is at work in our lives. Only God can make a Christian!

The classes will meet on Sunday afternoons for 4 weeks. After the classes conclude I will meet individually with families about where we go from here. For those who chose to be confirmed or baptized this will enable this to occur Easter Sunday April 1.

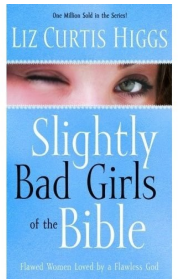

A FEW NOTES FROM THE ASSOCIATE PASTOR

On January 31, just past, we experienced an unique God-event in nature: On the same night, we had a partial lunar eclipse, a “blue moon” (two full moons in one calendar month), a “blood moon” (when the moon appears red as it rises), and a “super moon” (when the moon’s orbit brings it very close to the earth). All of these things are in God’s ordering of the universe, the “harmony of the spheres.” Rarely do all of these moon aspects fall together, and one cannot help but consider the hand of God which wrought the universe, setting in motion the complex orbits of overlapping cycles which produce such events.
